Dear Sir/Madam:

The Voorheesville Farmer's Market begins its 16th season this year and we would love for you to be a part of our successful market. We usually have between 16 and 18 vendors each season ranging from produce to take out meals to bread, and music.

Our season begins Wednesday, June 18th this year for 16 weeks and our hours are 3:30 - 6:30 pm. Generally we see attendance of approximately 70 - 100 each week. We charge \$160 for a 10 x 10 foot space for the season, or \$110 biweekly for a 10 x 10 foot space for the season. We have some artisans that come once or twice a season but our market is mainly a food based market.

We advertise in the TU, Altamont Enterprise and The Spotlight newspapers. We're located at the First United Methodist Church 68 Maple Ave. Voorheesville Rt. 85A which is the main road in the Village of Voorheesville. Many of our vendors have been with us since the beginning. All of our vendors feel our patrons are very friendly and many people are weekly attendees.

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2025 Rules & Regulations

1. The Farmer's Market will operate on Wednesdays from June 18 - Oct. 1 from 3:30-6:30 p.m.
2. No selling or bagging may occur until 3:30.
3. No one should dismantle their booth **until 6:30 pm.**
4. Sellers must have their market sites dismantled, packed up, and cleaned within one hour of the market closure.
5. 80% of the products offered for sale must be produced by the seller on lands or in production facilities they own or operate. If a farmer grows fruits and vegetables, another producer can't buy those products for resale.
6. Bedding plants, nursery products, and cut flowers must be grown on your farm.
7. Sellers must have a sign clearly showing their name.
8. Each seller will be responsible for all equipment and supplies for the setup of a booth. Displays should be constructed in a way that they do not block customer walkways or pose any other hazard to customers.
9. Vendors who provide samples and/or products that will result in waste material, such as cups, rinds, and corn cobs, must provide containers for waste disposal.
10. Sellers must notify the market manager in advance if they will be absent
11. **You must have weights and ropes to tie down tents in case of high winds. If you don't have weights, you will not be allowed to put up your tent.**
12. **NO styrofoam or plastic bags allowed. All containers must be recyclable.**
